1 January 2014	The Georgian State Ministry for Reintegration is renamed into State Ministry for Reconciliation and Civic Equality in a move that Tbilisi officials say will help engagement with the breakaway regions of Abkhazia and South Ossetia
4 January 2014	Russia pledges over 180 million dollars to the breakaway regions of Abkhazia and South Ossetia in 2014–2016 through a decree signed by Prime Minister Dmitry Medvedev with the financial aid to be provided via the Russian Ministry of Construction
14 January 2014	Hungary becomes the twelfth country to recognize Georgia's neutral travel documents designed for residents of the breakaway regions of Abkhazia and South Ossetia
16 January 2014	Georgian Prime Minister Irakli Garibashvili says that Russia lacks the levers to deter the country's signing of an Association Agreement with the European Union although provocations are expected
20 January 2014	Georgian President Giorgi Margvelashvili meets with his Turkish counterpart Abdullah Gül and Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdoğan during a visit to Turkey that includes meetings with representatives of the Georgian diaspora
30 January 2014	Czech President Milos Zeman says during Armenian President Serzh Sarkisian's official visit to Prague that the mass killings of Armenians during the Ottoman empire amounted to a "genocide"

3 February 2014	Azerbaijani parliament speaker Oqtay Asadov calls on religious clerics to perform prayers in Azeri and not in Arabic to make it easier for people to fully understand the prayer
4 February 2014	European Council President Herman Van Rompuy says that one of the EU's main objectives is the signing of an Association Agreement with Georgia before the end of the year following talks with Georgian Prime Minister Irakli Garibashvili
5 February 2014	EU Enlargement Commissioner Stefan Füle says that Russian pressure on

	the EU's Eastern neighbors is unacceptable and it should not interfere in Georgia's and Moldova's efforts to sign Association Agreements with the EU later this year
10 February 2014	Georgian President Giorgi Margvelashvili says he will "thoroughly" consider recent remarks by Russian President Vladimir Putin indicating a willingness to sit down for talks
10 February 2014	Azerbaijani foreign minister Elmar Mammadyarov says during a visit to Iraq that Baku is open to shipping Iraqi natural gas to Europe via Azerbaijan's pipeline network
10 February 2014	Up to 17 Georgian prison inmates in the Georgian western province of Imereti are hospitalized after harming themselves in protest at what they call abusive prison conditions
16 February 2014	About 1,000 people gather in downtown Baku to protest against the government's offer of what they see as too low housing compensation for the destruction of homes as a part of an urban renewal plan
17 February 2014	Former Georgian Prime Minister Vano Merabishvili is sentenced to five years in prison on charges of abuse of office, bribery of voters and inefficient use of budget funds
18 February 2014	The Azeri investigative journalist Khadija Ismayilova is summoned for questioning as a witness by the Department for Grave Crimes in Baku in an investigation into the leaking of state secrets
24 February 2014	Georgian Prime Minister Irakli Garibashvili meets with US President Barack Obama and Vice President Joe Biden in Washington. They urge Garibashvili to work with civil society and the country's political leaders to advance democracy and the rule of law, while thanking Georgia for being a reliable partner in global and regional issues
24 February 2014	Russian Prime Minister Dmitry Medvedev and Armenian Prime Minister Tigran Sarkisian meet in the Black Sea resort of Sochi to discuss bilateral ties including Armenia's roadmap to join the Russia-led customs union
27 February 2014	Georgian President Giorgi Margvelashvili starts an official two-days visit to Armenia and meets with his counterpart Serzh Sarkisian before holding talks with the head of the Armenian Apostolic Church, Catholicos Garegin II
27 February 2014	Georgian former Prime Minister Vano Merabishvili receives another jail sentence of four and a half years after being found guilty of exceeding his powers while dispersing protesters in 2011
27 February 2014	A French court rules not to extradite former Georgian Defense Minister David Kezerashvili who is suspected of money laundering and illegal property sales in Georgia
28 February 2014	Former Georgian warlord Emzar Kvitsiani is arrested on landing at Tbilisi

	airport after having served as governor in the Kodori Gorge in Western Georgia in the 1990s under former Georgian President Eduard Shevardnadze

1 March 2014	Armenian Deputy Foreign Minister Shavarsh Kocharian says that Armenia is ready to do the preparatory work to join the Russia-led customs unions which also includes Kazakhstan and Belarus within weeks
4 March 2014	EU Enlargement Commissioner Stefan Füle meets with Georgian Foreign Minister Maia Panjikidze on a visit to Tbilisi and expresses continued support for the country's efforts to build closer ties with the European Union
7 March 2014	The chief of the Azerbaijani parliament's Committee for Security and Defense, Ziyafat Asgarov, says that Azerbaijan is considering amendments to strengthen its antiterrorism laws that would increase penalties for involvement in "international terrorism, financing of terrorism, organizing, planning, and preparing terrorist attacks, intentionally stirring panic among the people, and using media outlets, the Internet, and social networks" for extremist purposes
14 March 2014	Romanian Prime Minister Victor Ponta visits Georgia following a visit to Moldova and says the EU should do "a lot more" for the two countries and Romania is the best advocate of Georgia and Moldova within the Union
17 March 2014	The leaders in the breakaway regions of Abkhazia and South Ossetia recognize the referendum for independence in Crimea
17 March 2014	A court in Azerbaijan sentences Ilqar Mammadov, head of the Republican Alternative movement and Tofiq Yaqublu, deputy head of the Musavat Party, respectively to seven and five years in prison for charges related to mass disturbances during riots in the town of Ismayilli in January 2013
21 March 2014	The Georgian leadership hails the EU's decision to sign the Association Agreement in June instead of August 2014 and congratulates Ukraine on signing the political part of the Association Agreement
21 March 2014	A forensic pathologist is arrested in Georgia on suspicion of negligence in his examination of the bodies of former Prime Minister Zurab Zhvania and his friend Raul Usupov, both found dead in 2005 after they were apparently killed by carbon monoxide poisoning leaking from a faulty gas heater
22 March 2014	The prosecutor's office in Georgia summons former President Mikheil Saakashvili for questioning as a witness in criminal investigations related to ten cases including a possible probe into the death of former Prime Minister Zurab Zhvania in 2005
23 March 2014	The US Department of State says that it is concerned by the decision of prosecutors in Georgia to summon former President Mikheil Saakashvili for questioning as it "raises legitimate concerns about political retribution"

25 March 2014	The spokesman of Abkhaz leader Sergei Bagapsh, Kristian Bzhania, said that holding a referendum on whether Abkhazia wants to join Russia or not is “out of the question”
25 March 2014	EU Commissioner for Enlargement and European Neighborhood Štefan Füle says in a tweet that he is watching with concern the Georgian prosecutors’ decision to summon former Georgian President Mikheil Saakashvili for questioning
25 March 2014	A group of environmental activists disrupt an international mining conference in Yerevan where experts had gathered to discuss ecological safety in Armenia’s mining sector
26 March 2014	US President Barack Obama says at a press conference after the EU–US Summit in Brussels that there are no “immediate plans” for expanding NATO membership to Georgia and Ukraine
27 March 2014	The US co-chair of the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe’s (OSCE) Minsk Group on the Nagorno-Karabakh conflict, James Warlick, reports on Twitter that the presidents of Armenia and Azerbaijan have met on the sidelines of the Nuclear Security Summit in The Hague on 24–25 March 2014
27 March 2014	Former Georgian President Mikheil Saakashvili rejects an offer made by prosecutors in Tbilisi to be questioned via Skype
31 March 2014	The three sons of late Georgian President Zviad Gamsakhurdia call on the current authorities in Georgia to resume the official investigation into his death which was shelved in 2004
31 March 2014	Georgia signs an agreement to establish diplomatic relations with the South Pacific island nation of Tuvalu which has retracted its decision to recognize Abkhazia and South Ossetia under a previous government in 2011

2 April 2014	Armenia’s Constitutional Court rules that several clauses in the controversial new law on pensions are illegal
2 April 2014	Georgian President Giorgi Margvelashvili starts a two-days visit to Poland and meets with his counterpart Bronisław Komorowski and Prime Minister Donald Tusk
3 April 2014	Armenian Prime Minister Tigran Sarkisian steps down after six years in office
4 April 2014	Former secretary of Georgia’s National Security Council (NSC) Giga Bokeria is questioned by prosecutors in connection with an ongoing investigation into the misspending of budgetary funds at the NSC
7 April 2014	Georgian Interior Minister Alexander Tchikaidze says that the United

	National Movement party aims to “destabilize” the country and “overthrow state institutions” in an interview with a Georgian weekly newspaper
8 April 2014	The Georgian Defense Ministry says that a Georgian special mountain battalion has been deployed at an airbase in Kandahar as part of the ISAF mission in Afghanistan
8 April 2014	The Azerbaijani Defense Ministry says that an officer and two conscripts have been killed in a mine explosion at the border with an Armenian-controlled region
9 April 2014	Azerbaijani President Ilham Aliyev meets with his Iranian counterpart Hassan Rohani in Tehran to discuss strengthening ties between the two countries and the status of the Caspian Sea
9 April 2014	Danish Foreign Minister Martin Lidegaard meets with his Georgian counterpart Maia Panjikidze and Prime Minister Irakli Garibashvili in Tbilisi and says that his visit aims to send a strong signal showing Danish and EU support for Georgia
13 April 2014	Ovik Abraamian is appointed as new Prime Minister in Armenia taking over from Tigran Sarkisian
14 April 2014	EU foreign ministers reaffirm their support during a meeting in Luxembourg for an “early” signature of the Association Agreements, including the comprehensive free trade agreements, with Georgia and Moldova no later than June
14 April 2014	The EU will hold investment conferences in Georgia and Moldova during the visit of EU Commission President José Manuel Barroso to the two countries on 12 and 13 June 2014
16 April 2014	Russian Deputy Foreign Minister Grigory Karasin declares the sixth round of talks on the normalization of Georgian–Russian ties “constructive” after meeting with the Georgian prime minister’s envoy for relations with Russia Zurab Abashidze in Prague and discussing economic and tourism relations
21 April 2014	The Azerbaijani Prosecutor-General’s Office charges journalist Rauf Mirqadirov with high treason for having allegedly worked with Armenia’s security services and provided them with information on Azerbaijan’s state secrets
22 April 2014	Iranian President Hassan Rouhani meets with newly appointed Georgian ambassador to Tehran Ioseb Chakhvashvili and stresses the importance of developing a railway project to link Iran with Georgia via Azerbaijan
24 April 2014	French foreign minister Laurent Fabius and German foreign minister Frank-Walter Steinmeier meet with the Georgian leadership in Tbilisi ahead of Georgia’s signing of an Association Agreement with the European Union
25 April 2014	Head of the Georgian Orthodox Church Patriarch Ilia II says that Georgia

	should enter European structures as “it is necessary for us”
27 April 2014	Azerbaijani authorities detain prominent human rights activist Leyla Yunus, and her husband, Arif Yunus, at Baku airport as they prepare to travel to Doha

1 May 2014	NATO Secretary General’s Special Representative for the Caucasus and Central Asia James Appathurai says during a visit to Georgia that the country “continues to improve” on its path toward NATO and the Alliance is considering next steps to bring it “even closer”
6 May 2014	The presidents of Azerbaijan, Georgia and Turkey gather in Tbilisi for a trilateral summit to discuss cooperation in energy, trade, transportation and economic sectors
7 May 2014	An antidiscrimination law comes into force in Georgia that is opposed by the head of the Georgian Orthodox Church Patriarch Ilia II as it includes “sexual orientation” and “gender identity” on the list of prohibited grounds for discrimination
9 May 2014	Armenian President Serzh Sarkisian visits the disputed region of Nagorno-Karabakh to mark Victory Day
12 May 2014	French President Francois Hollande urges the EU during a visit to Yerevan to accept a “specific model for Armenia” that would allow the country to enter into an Association Agreement with the EU while joining a Russian-led Customs Union
13 May 2014	French President Francois Hollande ends a South Caucasus tour in Tbilisi aimed at developing EU–South Caucasus relations and addressing security threats in connection with the Ukrainian crisis
22 May 2014	Russian Foreign Ministry spokesman Alexander Lukashevich says that it is Georgia’s sovereign right to sign an Association Agreement with the European Union, but it should consider the possible consequences pointing at Georgian exports to Russia
26 May 2014	The foreign ministers of Azerbaijan, Turkey and Turkmenistan discuss bilateral and trilateral ties in Baku and sign the Baku declaration for cooperation between the three Turkic-speaking countries in the spheres of energy, transportation, culture, tourism and education
26 May 2014	The head of an election watchdog in Azerbaijan Anar Mammadli is sentenced to five and a half years in detention for tax evasion and illegal business activities
27 May 2014	A Tbilisi court acquits former Georgian Defense Minister Davit Kezerashvili on charges of money-laundering and illegal property sales

29 May 2014	The Georgian Parliament passes a package of legislative amendments with its first reading that increases oversight mechanisms over government surveillance agencies, but does not envisage restricting the security agencies' capabilities to access directly telecommunications service providers' networks
30 May 2014	Georgian Prime Minister Irakli Garabishvili says that the Georgian police is "completely depoliticized" during a ceremony to mark the Georgian Police Day in the Black Sea town of Batumi

1 June 2014	Abkhaz de-facto President Aleksandr Ankvab announces that he is stepping down in order to maintain stability in Abkhazia following demonstrations demanding the government's resignation
2 June 2014	German Chancellor Angela Merkel meets with Georgian Prime Minister Irakli Garibashvili in Berlin and hails Tbilisi for pursuing European integration as well as trying to normalize relations with Russia, while saying that she does not think that a Membership Action Plan (MAP) for Georgia will be on the agenda of the NATO summit in Wales in September
3 June 2014	OSCE's chairman in office and Swiss Foreign Minister Didier Burkhalter arrives in Yerevan at the end of a South Caucasus tour to discuss Armenia–EU ties and the situation in the disputed region of Nagorno-Karabakh
5 June 2014	Georgian peacekeepers head to the Central African Republic to join a European Union peacekeeping mission
7 June 2014	U.S. Vice President Joe Biden meets with Georgian President Giorgi Margvelashvili on the sidelines of the inauguration ceremony of new Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko in Kiev
9 June 2014	Georgian Deputy Foreign Minister Davit Jalagania meets with the Turkish ambassador to Georgia to convey protest over the visit of a group of Turkish MPs to the breakaway region of Abkhazia
11 June 2014	Georgian Prime Minister Irakli Garibashvili says that comparing Crimea with the two breakaway regions of Abkhazia and South Ossetia is a "big mistake" as Russia is "not interested in annexing" the two regions
12 June 2014	European Commission President Jose Manuel Barroso arrives in Tbilisi and "underlines the EU support" for Georgia which is ahead of signing an Association Agreement with the Union
12 June 2014	German diplomat Herbert Salber is nominated as the new EU's special envoy to the South Caucasus
13 June 2014	Several civil society organizations in Georgia ask the EU in an open letter to European Commissioner for Enlargement and Neighbourhood Policy Štefan Füle to extend the mission of its special adviser for legal reforms and human

24 June 2014	Activists protest Azerbaijani President Ilham Aliyev’s speech at a session of the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe (PACE) in Strasbourg
25 June 2014	NATO Secretary-General Anders Fogh Rasmussen says the upcoming NATO summit in Wales in September will not address the question of

	granting Georgia a Membership Action Plan (MAP)
26 June 2014	The Russian Foreign Ministry announces that citizens of the Commonwealth Independent States (CIS), excluding member states of the Customs Union and Eurasian Economic Union (EES), will no longer be able to use their national identification documents to enter Russian territory as of 1 January 2015
27 June 2014	Georgia and the EU sign an association agreement, including a deep and comprehensive free trade area (DCFTA), with Georgian Prime Minister Irakli Garibashvili saying at the signing ceremony that Georgia is “taking a big step towards free Europe”
27 June 2014	Georgian Prime Minister Irakli Garibashvili welcomes Russia’s “constructive policy” and says that it has kept its promise not to interfere with the signing of an association agreement between Georgia and the EU
29 June 2014	US Congressman and Helsinki Commission Co-Chairman Chris Smith calls for a special envoy to be named to mediate between Armenia and Azerbaijan in the dispute over Nagorno-Karabakh during a visit to Azerbaijan
30 June 2014	Swedish Foreign Minister Carl Bildt holds talks with the Georgian authorities in Tbilisi and representatives of the opposition United National Movement party and underlines the importance of implementing the association agreement with the EU to accelerate Georgia’s modernization

3 July 2014	Ukrainian Justice Minister Pavlo Petrenko and Minister of Infrastructure Maxim Burbak visit Georgia after the Georgian Prime Minister’s office says that Georgian Justice Minister Tea Tsulukiani has been tasked to visit Ukraine to share Georgia’s reform experience with Ukrainian counterparts

18 July 2014	The Georgian Parliament ratifies the Association Agreement between Georgia and the European Union at an extraordinary session
22 July 2014	An Armenian mayor is injured together with two other persons and one killed after their car hit a mine in the Kashatagh province of the disputed region of Nagorno Karabakh
24 July 2014	The Georgian prosecutor's office says that it has reached an agreement with a group of international criminal law experts to consult regarding high-profile and sensitive cases involving high-ranked officials
25 July 2014	President of the NATO Parliamentary Assembly Hugh Bayley meets with Georgian leaders in Tbilisi and says that Georgia is "the most important partner that NATO has"
